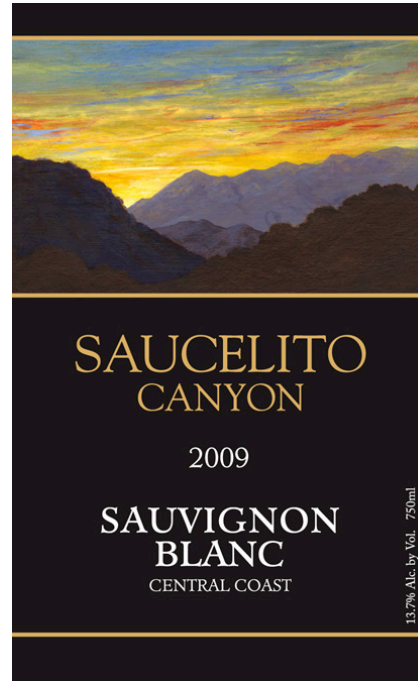

Winemaker's Notes:

Our 2009 Sauvignon Blanc is comprised of a medley of cool and warm climate fruit fermented entirely in stainless steel to preserve the wine's varietal aromatics and natural acidity. It begins with a floral aroma of white peach with just a hint of grassiness. The palate is crisp and clean with tropical flavors of mango and pineapple. The finish presents well-rounded herbaceous flavors accented by fresh pear and slight minerality.

Pairing Suggestions: This wine will pair perfectly with soft artisan cheeses & fruit or a classic Peruvian ceviche. Also a great wine to take to sushi!
